The debates will be stimulated by presentations from invited guests, workshop activities, mind games and social events. But we will also invite the local public to share their thoughts and opinions during special "open discussion sessions".

Your preparations:

Before the seminar all participants must prepare a draft article (2 - 4 pages) that gives your opinion on the future of Europe. Please read through the Demos Community College mind-map and comment or find inspiration in one or more of the statements given in the mind-map. Participants will read through each others essays during the seminar and help each other finalize them before they are published in "ACCENT – A European Demos". The draft for an article
