NEW CONSIDERATION (from 2006/7): We would like to make it possible for members to help presenting our ideas within their local media, organisations, parties and so on. It is the states that prevent the European political fora from taking action, so it makes sense to target the national level in particular.

The proof is there and texts are there (press-releases, articles, ideas, declarations) as inspiration for the members.

This leads to a NEW CONCLUSION (from 2006/7): It would make sense to share, if articles are written and/or translated in the different languages. We need to encourage members to (a) get in contact with each others locally in order to (b) spread the ideas in the local surroundings, and (e) we need to set up a corps of voluntary translators.
